

Skyloch Villas Procedure for ESA
(Emotional Support Animal)

- 1. An applicant for an ESA must submit a prescription/letter to the Skyloch Board from either their Physician or a Licensed Mental Health Professional (LMHP) typically a psychologist, psychiatrist, or therapist, stating that the applicant suffers from a mental or emotional disability and an ESA is necessary to alleviate the symptom's. The Physician or LMHP is not required to disclose the particulars of the mental or emotional disability.**
- 2. This letter must be on LMHP letterhead, include license information and contact info to verify letter. The Board of Directors can verify LMHP license and authenticity of letter.**
- 3. If the LMHP is out-of-state, they must indicate that they have provided care or services to the person on at least one prior occasion before issuing the opinion. Tele-counseling may qualify as acceptable.**
- 4. The applicant must provide proof of County and Local licensing and vaccinations for their ESA.**
- 5. Please note the Description (Breed and Size) of your ESA.**
